SUNSET LAKES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Sunset Lakes Elementary School is closing out its SMART Program renovations, with all construction on campus having reached the finish line. Among the various improvements to its facilities is a brand new roof, with the old roofing system having been demolished and replaced. To enhance air quality at the school, two chilled water pumps were replaced for the administrative offices, Media Center, cafeteria, and classrooms in Building 1, and a new chiller was installed to serve classrooms in Building 4.
