

The SMART Bond Program focuses on improving schools and the educational experience of students and faculty at 232 SMART funded Broward County Public Schools, in the overarching categories of Safety, Music & Art, Athletics, Renovation, and Technology.

PRIMARY RENOVATIONS DISTRICT HIGHLIGHTS

- Construction is underway at Ramblewood Middle School with contractors now mobilized
- Challenger Elementary School is ready to begin construction
- Tamarac Elementary School media center renovations are now complete



SCHOOL CHOICE ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM

As part of the School Choice Enhancement Program (SCEP), schools are allocated \$100,000 to spend on custom improvements to their campuses and curriculums.

FEATURED PRIMARY RENOVATIONS

MAPLEWOOD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL



Framing has been completed for the media center and restroom renovations, while piping work for the fire sprinkler improvements remain ongoing.



RAMBLEWOOD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

At Ramblewood Elementary, the base and structure of the new HVAC chiller has been framed and concrete has been poured. In the media center, the new floors, paint, shelving and furniture were installed. Installation of air handling units and ductwork are underway.





The exterior walls of all buildings at Riverglades Elementary School received a fresh coat of paint while contractors await permits for roofing, fire alarm and fire sprinkler upgrades.



WESTCHESTER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Framing for the new media center is complete as well as the gutting of the two restrooms being renovated. Meanwhile, the installation of the fire alarm conduits is still in progress and the fire sprinkler system is scheduled to be replaced soon.
